"AT FIRST I REALLY HATED WORDS, AND [NOW] THEY'VE BECOME THE ONE THING I LOVE."

CARMELO ISAAC BATISTA, GRADE 12

"I always hated words. Imagine you just discovered a cave full of secrets, written in a language that would take forever to decode. The only thing separating you from these wonders are the words themselves."

For Carmelo Batista, this is how it feels to be dyslexic, and how it always felt for him in elementary school. Unaware of his learning disability, from an early age, Carmelo did not understand why he was not advancing as quickly as his peers. For that reason, in addition to experiences with constant bullying and feelings of not being accepted, Carmelo began to miss school. He stopped doing his homework because he was tired of trying to understand, and eventually found himself being held back a grade level for the second time.

The beginning of Carmelo's story resonates with many Latino young men like him growing up in some of the most challenging neighborhoods in the Bronx. Without an education Carmelo could have easily been drawn into a life in the streets, but his path began to change course as he started to meet mentors who took time to show him another way.

Starting as a 9th grader at Eagle Bronx, Carmelo shares that he did not feel confident in himself and he always sat in back of the classroom. He was quiet, felt self conscious about his size, and that he had nothing to offer to anyone. That was until Carmelo began to be exposed to life changing opportunities he never thought would be possible for him. He was encouraged to enter a writing competition where he won first place. From that point on Carmelo began writing and reading poetry, and taking his academic and community commitments seriously. His confidence began to build further after hiking over 800 miles across Wyoming and going toe for toe with young men twice his size on the wrestling mat.

This past summer Carmelo had the opportunity to participate in two Eagle Academy partnership programs that he attributes to changing him for the better—the Center for Creative Youth (CCY) at Wesleyan University and Global Glimpse. Looking back at his journey, today Carmelo cannot believe how far he has come in his relationship to words. Now in his senior year at Eagle Bronx, Carmelo looks forward with excitement to entering the college of his choice from a pick of schools. He is inspired to pursue a double degree in English and journalism, with aspirations for law school in the future.

"[Before Eagle] I did not see myself as a leader, but today I can say I am a leader. In middle school, I became a part of a world that at first I couldn't read. In high school, I gained the ability to write stories and connect to others. Now as I enter college, I want to become a writer so that I can use words to inspire others in the same way words have inspired me." Today, Carmelo's possibilities are endless and because of his time at Eagle Academy he will have the opportunity to do just that.
